**What is a Be Strong Online Ambassador training day?**

The Be Strong Online Ambassador Training Days are all day events which provide a great opportunity to meet and share ideas with passionate staff, professionals and young people from schools, academies and organisations in your local area.

**Who is the training for?**

This training is aimed at young people in Year 8 and above from schools across the United Kingdom.

**What will students learn from the day?**

After receiving our training, students become Be Strong Online Ambassadors and are responsible for running short educational sessions for students on online safety, facilitating discussions about students' digital lives and online behaviour, and running campaigns across their school to raise awareness of digital issues. Our approach is peer-led. We recognise that young people are the best agents for change in their schools and communities and are best placed to help their peers learn about the online world.

**How many staff/students should attend from each school?**

We recommend sending a team of between 6-15 young people per school along with up to 2 adults in attendance. The maximum group size **including** staff and students from each school should be no more than a group of 17. This group size allows for a manageable team in order to implement the programme successfully.
